A **MOTION** was made by Schweitzer, seconded by Capone to accept Council President Kresge's resignation from his 4<sup>th</sup> Ward Council Seat. All were in favor. **MOTION** carried. A **MOTION** was made by Schweitzer, seconded by Augustine to reappoint James Kresge as an at large member of Borough Council, filling the previously vacated seat.

**PUBLIC COMMENT:**

1. Dave Owens was present from Liberty Fire Company to give Council an update regarding their parking lot project.

**ACTION ITEMS:**

1. A **MOTION** to approve the minutes dated July 13, 2020 and July 27, 2020 was made by Bilotta, seconded by Goffredo. All were in favor. **MOTION** carried.
2. A **MOTION** to approve payment of the bills totaling \$217,665.86 to be paid was made by Goffredo, seconded by Bilotta. All were in favor. **MOTION** carried.
3. Manager Dysard reported that the borough's current electricity supply contract is close to expiration. Dysard reviewed the electric price quotes for a three-year and four-year contract with Council. A **MOTION** was made by Goffredo, seconded by Schweitzer to approve a 4-year contract with AEP Energy. All were in favor. **MOTION** carried
4. Manager Dysard stated that the police union signed the police collective bargaining agreement. A **MOTION** was made by Bilotta, seconded by Augustine to approve the 5-year Police Collective Bargaining Agreement. All were in favor. **MOTION** carried.
5. A **MOTION** was made by Capone, seconded by Schweitzer to approve police directives 1.2.2 (Retired Law Enforcement Officer Identification Card) and 3.3.1 (Search and Seizure). All were in favor. **MOTION** carried.

**COUNCIL COMMENTS:**

1. Chief Felchok stated that he is updating the police directives when new standards are released.
2. Mayor Kerzner updated Council regarding her recent duties as Mayor.

3. Manager Dysard included a letter from Ott Consulting in Council's meeting packet regarding Messinger Street and Tropical Storm Isaias that occurred on August 4<sup>th</sup>.
