3. A **MOTION** was made by Capone, seconded by Schweitzer to authorize the Tax Collector Compensation Ordinance #995. The annual increase will be \$300.00 for tax years 2022-2025. All were in favor. **MOTION** carried.
4. Brenda Valletta discussed with Council the updated list and minor adjustments that were made to the per capita exoneration list from the last Council Meeting. A **MOTION** was made by Capone, seconded by Schweitzer to approve the 2020 per capita exoneration list. All were in favor. **MOTION** carried.
5. Manager Dysard and Council continued their discussion regarding no parking on Market Street between 1st and 4th. The borough will send letters to the property owners and current residents asking for their input.
