CALL TO ORDER AND PLEDGE TO FLAG

ROLL CALL

ACTION ITEMS:

- 1. A **MOTION** to approve payment of the bills totaling \$304,280.03 to be paid was made by Bilotta, seconded by Fogel. All were in favor. **MOTION** carried.
- 2. Jeff Ott was present to discuss the Broadway Storm Sewer Project with Council and answer questions. The Borough received a grant to reconstruct a portion of the failed storm sewer between 15 and 6 Broadway. A **MOTION** was made by Schweitzer, seconded by Goffredo to authorize advertisement of the Broadway Storm Sewer Project. All were in favor. **MOTION** carried.
- 3. A **MOTION** was made by Capone, seconded by Fogel to approve the 2019 list of per capita exonerations that was provided by the tax collector. All were in favor. **MOTION** carried.
- 4. A **MOTION** was made by Bilotta, seconded by Augustine to accept with regrets a letter of resignation from Krista Ashmore from the Park Board. All were in favor. **MOTION** carried.
- 5. Manager Dysard reported that at the January Authority Meeting the Board recommended the purchase of a new wasting valve/actuator due to the failure of the existing one. A **MOTION** was made by Goffredo, seconded by Schweitzer to approve the purchase not to exceed \$12,000. All were in favor. **MOTION** carried.

COUNCIL COMMENTS:

- 1. Mayor Kerzner updated Council on her recent duties as Mayor.
- Manager Dysard reported that the Borough was awarded a recycling grant for approximately \$125,000. Items for this grant include a front-end loader, woodchipper, fencing, gate and recycling signage. Some of these items would help the Borough in securing the yard-waste dumping area. Dysard will execute the grant documents.
- 3. Council President Kresge has been assisting the Fire Department with laying the groundwork for efforts to get state and federal assistance in getting funding for a new ladder truck. A letter was received from the Bangor School District stating that they are renewing the agreement with the Borough for a term of five years, commencing July 1, 2021. Kresge will meet with Bangor School District Representatives to discuss this agreement.
