2. Manager Dysard stated that the attorney representing the New Main Street Market, LLC was present to discuss with Council their request to transfer a liquor license for use at the market. The license would allow Main Street Market to sell beer and wine. A **MOTION** was made by Capone, seconded by Augustine to approve the resolution. All were in favor. **MOTION** carried.
3. Liberty Fire Company is requesting to close a portion of North Eight Street for their carnival scheduled on July 15th-17th from 5:00 P.M. to midnight. A **MOTION** was made by Schweitzer, seconded by Goffredo to approve the request. All were in favor. **MOTION** carried.

COUNCIL COMMENTS:

1. Council Member Capone commented that movie night at the park was a success.
2. Council President Kresge thanked the Park Board for movie night.
Kresge shared a listing of forty grants the borough has applied for in the past few years totaling \$4,371,623.00.
