1. Mayor Kerzner stated that a Bangor High School student made a comment to her that she hopes that graduation will be held at the stadium. Kresge stated that he heard from a representative from the Bangor School District that their goal is to have graduation at the stadium, but nothing is confirmed.
2. Council Member Ashmore asked if there was an update regarding the letter the Borough sent to the Bangor School District Board regarding the lease agreement. Council Member Goffredo stated that the letter was received but he has not heard a response.
3. Council Member Bilotta complimented Public Works on their plowing efforts this winter.
4. Council Member Schweitzer stated that he is going to run for the Bangor School Board.
5. Council Member Capone thanked Ahren Wedge for helping her when she fell.
6. Council President Kresge updated Council on the Bangor Wales youth outreach zoom project.
