ACTION ITEMS:

1. A **MOTION** to approve the minutes dated April 12, 2021 and April 26, 2021 was made by Ashmore, seconded by Bilotta. All were in favor. **MOTION** carried.
2. Manager Dysard discussed the grading and excavation ordinance with Council. This ordinance will help regulate earth disturbances/earth moving within the borough. A **MOTION** was made by Goffredo, seconded by Augustine to authorize advertisement of the Grading Ordinance #996. All were in favor. **MOTION** carried.
3. Manager Dysard discussed the amendments to the zoning ordinance with Council. The amendments would modify the Industrial/Commercial zoning district and add text to the Administration and Enforcement section of the ordinance. A **MOTION** was made by Bilotta, seconded by Ashmore to authorize advertisement of the Zoning Amendment Ordinance #997. All were in favor. **MOTION** carried.
4. Council President Kresge stated that the HBBA is requesting to close a portion (First to Main Street) of Broadway for an HBBA event on May 16th. Manager Dysard commented that they are also requesting that the borough allow patrons who purchase a marked cup to walk around within the event area. The HBBA and the individual liquor license permittees would be responsible for monitoring and enforcing restrictions on alcohol consumption within the closed portion of Broadway. A **MOTION** was made by Goffredo seconded by Ashmore to approve closing a portion of Broadway and allowing patrons to walk around the event area with an open container. All were in favor, **MOTION** carried.

COUNCIL COMMENTS:

1. Mayor Kerzner commented that she planted flowers in the containers downtown.
2. Council Member Schweitzer stated that he received an endorsement from the teacher's union regarding him running for the Bangor School Board.
3. Council Member Goffredo stated that the pool at the YMCA has been completed.
4. Council President Kresge stated that the Bangor School Board President is going to create an Ad Hoc committee to discuss the stadium.

A **MOTION** to adjourn the meeting and go into Executive Session at 7:21 P.M. to discuss personnel matters, with no action to follow was made by Ashmore, seconded by Augustine. All were in favor. **MOTION** carried.
