PUBLIC COMMENT:

1. The Bangor Elks received grant funds and Mike Jankowski was present to give a check to the Bangor Fire and Police Departments for \$1,250 each.

- 1. A **MOTION** to approve payment of the bills totaling \$333,408.14 to be paid was made by Bilotta, seconded by Ashmore. All were in favor. **MOTION** carried.
- 2. A **MOTION** was made by Schweitzer, seconded by Goffredo to authorize advertisement of the 2021 proposed budget. All were in favor. **MOTION** carried.
- 3. A **MOTION** to authorize advertisement of the 2021 Tax Ordinance #993 was made by Goffredo, seconded by Bilotta. All were in favor. **MOTION** carried.
- 4. A **MOTION** was made by Schweitzer, seconded by Capone to move forward with the 2021 Police Vehicle purchase. All were in favor, **MOTION** carried.
- 5. A **MOTION** to authorize advertisement of the Authority Pension Ordinance #994 was made by Capone, seconded by Goffredo. All were in favor. **MOTION** carried.
- 6. Manager Dysard gave Council a summary of the LED Street Light Conversion Project with Council and answered questions. Manager Dysard will move forward with the project.
- 7. Manager Dysard and Council continued their discussion regarding a no parking section (between 1st and 4th Streets) on Market Street. Chief Felchock prepared crash data for Council's review. Council agreed to have the borough send letters to the Market Street residents inviting them to the January 11th Council meeting to discuss.

COUNCIL COMMENTS:

- 1. Council Member Goffredo mentioned Bangor supporting Waste Management's application to expand the landfill. Council discussed and felt Bangor would currently remain neutral.
- Mayor Kerzner wished everyone a Happy Thanksgiving and asked for everyone to be conscious of COVID-19. Kerzner stated that Faith Sarisky was recognized as volunteer of the year by the Slate Belt Chamber of Commerce for the murals.

3. Council President Kresge and Council continued their discussion regarding a formal letter from the Borough being sent to the Bangor Area School Board to start formally discussing the stadium contract. Manager Dysard will draft a letter for Council's review.
