PUBLIC COMMENT:

1. Mark Rouch was present from 532 Elder Avenue to discuss with Council the parking on 5th and PA Avenue. Residents are parking close to the intersection on PA Avenue making visibility difficult when pulling out. Mr. Rouch is requesting to have a mirror on the telephone pole across the street from the intersection. Council will research this request.
Mr. Rouch also mentioned the closing of Murray Street. Manager Dysard stated that Council approved to close Murray Street to make this a courtyard for public use in consultation with the fire and police departments.

2. Manager Dysard reported that three individual applications have been received requesting a disabled parking space. All applicants have a permanent disabled license plate. A **MOTION** to approve the disabled parking sign application for 21 South 6th Street was made by Capone, seconded by Augustine. All were in favor. **MOTION** carried. A **MOTION** to approve the disabled parking sign application for 424 South Northampton Street was made by Bilotta, seconded by Goffredo. All were in favor. **MOTION** carried.
3. A **MOTION** was made by Capone, seconded by Augustine to approve, with regrets the resignation letter from Louise Williams resigning from the Planning Commission. All were in favor. **MOTION** carried. Mayor Kerzner thanked Ms. Williams for her work on the Planning Commission.
4. Manager Dysard reviewed the 2022 draft Authority & Borough budgets with Council and answered questions.

COUNCIL COMMENTS:

1. Chief Felchock mentioned that the Halloween Parade was a success but there was an unfortunate car accident that occurred outside of the parade route during the parade.
2. Council Member Schweitzer commented that the Halloween Parade was a success, but the children should be more aware of their surroundings when picking up the candy.
3. Council Member Goffredo mentioned that a structure fire occurred above the post office recently and complimented the quick response from the three local fire departments.
4. Council President Kresge thanked the Elks for sponsoring the Halloween Parade. Kresge also thanked his fellow Veterans, Councilmen Schweitzer and Chief Felchock for their service and wished them and everyone a Happy Veterans Day.
