PUBLIC COMMENTS:

1. Melanie Bingham was present from 319 North Fifth Street to discuss her sidewalk issues with Council. According to Ms. Bingham her neighbor did not acquire the proper sidewalk permit and damaged her sidewalk. Solicitor Ceraul and Manager Dysard stated that the borough can enforce the permit but the issues with the neighbor are a civil matter.

5. A **MOTION** was made by Augustine, seconded by Capone to approve the 2020 Road Program Paving Change Orders #1 and #2. All were in favor, **MOTION** carried.
6. A **MOTION** was made by Bilotta, seconded by Schweitzer to approve the 2020 Road Program Paving Payment Applications #1, #2 and #3. All were in favor. **MOTION** carried.
7. Manager Dysard discussed the PennDOT Winter Traffic Services Agreement with Council. The existing agreement the borough has with PennDOT is expiring. A **MOTION** was made by Schweitzer, seconded by Augustine to approve the new PennDOT agreement. All were in favor. **MOTION** carried.
8. Manager Dysard discussed the 2021 draft Authority & Borough budgets with Council and answered questions.
