A **MOTION** was made by Capone, seconded by Ashmore to appoint Marc Sperling to the Park and Recreation Advisory Board with a term expiring on 12/31/2025. All were in favor. **MOTION** carried.
- 4. A **MOTION** to approve Police Directives 3.4.3 (Temporary Holding Area), 3.4.4 (Detainee Intake and Monitoring Record). 4.1.2 (Northampton County Sexual Assault Protocol), and 4.9.1 (Missing Persons), was made by Capone, seconded by Schweitzer. All were in favor. **MOTION** carried.
