**ACTION ITEMS:**

1. A **MOTION** to approve payment of the bills totaling \$261,178.75 to be paid was made by Ashmore, seconded by Bilotta. All were in favor. **MOTION** carried.
2. Manager Dysard reviewed the proposal for the equipment needed to create a splash pad at the borough pool facility with Council. The estimated cost with construction is approximately \$300,000. A **MOTION** was made by Augustine, seconded by Capone to authorize submission of the LSA grant application and authorization of the Borough Manager to execute the necessary contractual grant documents. All were in favor. **MOTION** carried.
3. A letter of interest was received from Marc Sperling to serve on the Park and Recreation Advisory Board. A **MOTION** was made by Capone, seconded by Ashmore to appoint Marc Sperling to the Park and Recreation Advisory Board with a term expiring on 12/31/2025. All were in favor. **MOTION** carried.
4. A **MOTION** to approve Police Directives 3.4.3 (Temporary Holding Area), 3.4.4 (Detainee Intake and Monitoring Record), 4.1.2 (Northampton County Sexual Assault Protocol), and 4.9.1 (Missing Persons), was made by Capone, seconded by Schweitzer. All were in favor. **MOTION** carried.

**COUNCIL COMMENTS:**

1. Mayor Kerzner mentioned the borough's upcoming October events (100<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the Bangor Library, Oktoberfest, and the Elks Halloween Parade).
2. Council Member Schweitzer mentioned that he is a candidate in the upcoming election for Bangor School Board.
3. Council Member Bilotta commented that the Borough's September to Remember event at the park was a success.
