**APPROVAL OF MINUTES**

A **MOTION** to approve the minutes dated July 10, 2017 & July 24, 2017 was made by Bilotta, seconded by Engle. All were in favor. **MOTION** carried.

**APPROVAL OF BILLS TO BE PAID**

A **MOTION** to approve the bills totaling \$305,845.91 to be paid was made by Goffredo, seconded by Rhodes. All were in favor. **MOTION** carried.

**ACTION ITEMS**

1. Manager Dysard reported that after having a meeting with the County and the Emergency Management Coordinator the Borough updated its Emergency Operations Plan. A **MOTION** to approve the updated Emergency Operations Plan was made by Gorman, seconded by Engle. All were in favor. **MOTION** carried.
2. Manager Dysard stated that the final payment request from Bracalente Construction for the 2017 Road Program bid in the amount of \$62,745.00 was received. A **MOTION** was made by Goffredo, seconded by Bilotta to approve final payment for \$62,745.00 along with change order #1. All were in favor. **MOTION** carried.

## **COUNCIL COMMENTS**

1. Council Member Engle stated that residents are seeing new curbs and sidewalks being installed with the road street project. They asked if there are any programs in place for them to receive new sidewalks. Manager Dysard stated that there is not. Fire Chief Engle also mentioned that there was a bad accident on Stiles Road and 191 involving a school bus but there were no injuries.
2. Manager Dysard included the monthly budget reports for the Borough and Authority in the packets. The Borough received a grant for two digital speed display signs. Manager Dysard will work with Police Chief Felchock for the best locations. Manager Dysard met with and has been working on the union negotiation and the agreement for Public Works. Due to one employee retiring a full-time Public Works position will be advertised this month.
3. Police Chief Felchock stated that they received \$3,000 from the Washington Township VFW. Fifteen hundred dollars was given towards the Police Wish Fund and Fifteen hundred was given towards the K9 program.
4. Council President Kresge attended the recent school board meeting to highlight the Borough's Junior Council Program and mentioned the three most recent Bangor Council Junior Members with high regard.

## **ADJOURNMENT**

A **MOTION** to adjourn the meeting into Executive Session to discuss a legal matter with no action to follow was made by Rhodes, seconded by Engle. All were in favor. **MOTION** carried.
