- 5. A **MOTION** was made by Schweitzer, seconded by Engle to approve the Police Wish Fund Expenditure for \$450.00 to send Officer Kevin Lillis to the Penn State Justice & Safety Institute's Field Training Officer Program. All were in favor. **MOTION** carried.
- 6. A **MOTION** was made by Schweitzer, seconded by Engle to approve the Junior Council Person Program Resolution. All were in favor. **MOTION** carried.
- 7. A **MOTION** was made by Schweitzer, seconded by Goffredo to accept with regrets the letter of resignation from Jane Gorman from Borough Council. All were in favor. **MOTION** carried.

- 8. A **MOTION** was made by Schweitzer, seconded by Engle to accept the letters of resignations from Jane Gorman and Chad Ace (Authority Board), Kurt Krouse (Zoning Hearing Board), Nadine Moyer (Park Board) and Laura Antonow (Planning Commission Board). All were in favor. **MOTION** carried.
- 9. A **MOTION** was made by Engle, seconded by Schweitzer to approve the policy of grant applications being prioritized for Bangor Borough with Bangor Borough affiliated entities second and not including non-affiliated Bangor Borough entities. All were in favor. **MOTION** carried.
