- 5. A **MOTION** to amend section 2 (eliminating within 30 days from section dii, adding after 10% of the base amount of the installment payment in section dii and removing diii) in Tax Ordinance #988 was made by Schweitzer, seconded by Bilotta. All were in favor, **MOTION** carried. A **MOTION** to authorize advertisement of the 2020 Tax Ordinance #988, as amended was made by Engle, seconded by Schweitzer. All were in favor, **MOTION** carried.

- 1. Manager Dysard stated that the first Zoning Hearing Board meeting of the year is scheduled for November 18th regarding a fence installation at 545 Fairview Avenue.
