#### BOROUGH OF BANGOR COUNTY OF NORTHAMPTON COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA ORDINANCE NO. 992

# AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF BANGOR, NORTHAMPTON COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, VACATING UNIMPROVED SECTIONS OF SILK STREET AND AN UNNAMED ALLEY, AND REPEALING ALL INCONSISTENT ORDINANCES AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the Borough of Bangor is a duly organized exiting municipality and political subdivision within the County of Northampton, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania with office located at 197 Pennsylvania Avenue, Bangor, Northampton County, PA 18013; and

**WHEREAS**, the Borough is subject to the PA Borough Code which Code provides a process for petitioning to vacate a street, See 8 Pa C.S.A. Section 1732; and

**WHEREAS**, the Bangor Borough Council has the authority (by Ordinance) to vacate a street or portion thereof. See 8 Pa C.S.A. Section 1731(a)(2); and

WHEREAS, the definition of a "street" also includes <u>inter alia</u> an "alley". See 8 Pa C.S.A Section 1701; and

WHEREAS, the Bangor Borough Council, following a hearing, deems it necessary for the public convenience and for the general benefit and welfare of the public to vacate unimproved sections of Silk Street and an Unnamed Alley located within the Borough of Bangor and being more fully depicted in Exhibit "A" and described in Exhibit "B" both exhibits being attached hereto and made a part hereof, and

**NOW, THEREFORE,** incorporating the preceding paragraphs as if they were set forth herein, it is hereby **ORDAINED** and **ENACTED** by the Borough Council of the Borough of Bangor, County of Northampton and Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, as follows:

#### Section 1. Vacation of Unimproved Sections of Silk Street and an Unnamed Alley.

The unimproved section of Silk Street to be vacated comprises approximately 2,116 square feet or 0.0486 acres and the unimproved section of Unnamed Alley to be vacated comprises approximately 1,688 square feet or 0.0387 acres, said area is hereby vacated. A copy of a Map and Bearings and Distances Description of the areas of said vacation are attached hereto and marked as Exhibits "A" and "B" and are hereby made a part hereof.

#### Section 2. Repealer

Any Ordinance or part of an Ordinance conflicting with the provisions of this Ordinance shall be and the same is hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

#### Section 3. Severability

If any section, sub-section, provision, regulation, limitation, restriction, sentence, clause phrase or word in this Ordinance is declared by any reason to be illegal, unconstitutional, or invalid by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect or impair the validity of this Ordinance as a whole, or any other section, sub-section, provision, regulation, limitation, restriction, sentence, clause, phrase, word or remaining portion of this Ordinance. Borough Council hereby declares that it would have adopted this Ordinance and each section, sub-section, phrase and word thereof, irrespective of the fact that any one or more of the sections, sub-sections, provisions, regulations, limitations, restrictions, sentences, clauses, phrases or words may be declared illegal, unconstitutional or invalid.

#### Section 4. Effective Date



Along the southerly side of the said twelve feet wide unnamed alley and crossing the said twenty-four feet wide right-of-way of Silk Street, South 76 degrees 20 minutes 49 seconds East, a distance of 24.07 feet to a point being the southeast intersection of rights-of-ways of the same, said point also being the northwest corner of land now or formerly belonging to H.A. Berkheimer Inc. (tax parcel E9NE1B-11-4); thence
- 3. Along said land of H.A. Berkheimer, South 09 degrees 24 minutes 00 seconds West, distance of 87.99 feet to a point in the same; thence
- 4. Crossing the aforementioned twenty-four feet wide right-of-way of Silk Street, North 77 degrees 15 minutes 00 seconds West, a distance of 24.04 feet to the place of BEGINNING.


