

Patrol Officer Examination Notice - Bangor Borough Police Department, Northampton County, PA

Forms required to be completed to apply for the position of Entry Level Patrol Officer are available at the Bangor Borough Municipal Building, 197 Pennsylvania Avenue, Bangor, PA 18013 and on the Borough's website, www.bangorborough.org in the Forms and Documents folder. The Borough Administration Building is open from 8:00 AM-4:00 PM, Monday through Friday. Call (610) 588-2216 if you have any questions.

The application period begins on July 11, 2022. Completed applications must be hand-delivered or mailed to the Borough's Administration Building and include payment of a non-refundable \$25.00 application fee. The Borough of Bangor will not accept application packets hand-delivered, or post marked after the application deadline, or which do not include payment of the application fee. You cannot apply online, and any online applications emailed or received will not be accepted. The application period deadline is August 5, 2022.

General Qualification for All Applicants

This is a civil service position. Applicants must have reached their twenty-first (21st) birthday before the deadline for submitting applications. Applicants shall possess a diploma from an accredited high school or a graduate equivalency diploma (GED). In addition, every applicant must be a United States Citizen, be physically and mentally fit to perform the full duties of a police officer, and prior to appointment, possess a valid motor vehicle operator's license issued by the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. Applicants must have completed and passed the police officers' training course approved by the Municipal Police Officers Education and Training Commission (MPOETC), as set forth in 53 Pa. C.S. ss 2161 et seq. at the time of examination. Other mandatory components are a background investigation, a medical examination, and a psychological examination.
