ACTION ITEMS:

1. A **MOTION** to approve the minutes dated June 10, 2024, and June 24, 2024 was made by Donnelly, seconded by Capone. All were in favor. **MOTION** carried.
2. Manager Reider and Council continued their discussion regarding the disabled parking sign application that was received for 44 Kline Street. Council President Kresge read Resolution 2001-15 to Council regarding handicap parking on public streets in the borough. Manager Reider and Council reviewed and discussed the resolution. A **MOTION** was made by Sperling, seconded by Augustine to deny the disabled parking sign application request due to the applicant having off street parking availability. A **MOTION** was made by Augustine, seconded by Donnelly to approve rescheduling the November Council meeting to November 13th. All were in favor. **MOTION** carried.
4. Manager Reider reviewed the 2023 Borough Audit and answered questions. A **MOTION** was made by Augustine, seconded by Capone to accept the 2023 Borough Audit. All were in favor. **MOTION** carried.

COUNCIL COMMENTS:

1. Mayor DeFranco commented that it has been a great summer for the pool. The mayor mentioned that the Liberty Fire Co. Annual Carnival is from July 11th-13th.
2. Council Member Schweitzer gave Council an Authority update.

3. Council Member Capone gave Council an update on the upcoming Park Board events.
4. Manager Reider advised Council that the air-conditioner at the library is failing. Quotes for a new system range between \$12,000-\$16,000. Mayor DeFranco suggested contacting Air Dynamics Heating & Air Conditioning for a quotation.
Reider gave Council a grant and pool/park update.
