ORDINANCE NO. 1005

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF BANGOR, NORTHAMPTON COUNTY,
PENNSYLVANIA, REPEALING BOROUGH OF BANGOR ORDINANCE NO.511
ENACTED JANUARY 20TH, 1964 AND BOROUGH OF BANGOR ORDINANCE NO.883
ENACTED DECEMBER 27TH, 2004.**

WHEREAS, the Borough of Bangor has since 1964 imposed a per capita tax per resident of the Borough; and

WHEREAS, the Borough has determined the expense of collecting and cost of administering the tax exceeds the value of the amounts collected;

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby **ORDAINED** and **ENACTED** by the Borough Council of the Borough of Bangor, County of Northampton, and Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, as follows:

SECTION 1: Ordinance Nos. 511 and 883 of the Borough of Bangor, relating to the imposition of and collection of a per capita tax is hereby repealed.

SECTION 2: Nothing in this Ordinance is intended to impair the collection of taxes imposed under the authority of the repealed ordinances for calendar years prior to 2025.

SECTION 3: This change shall be effective January 1, 2025.
