PUBLIC COMMENT:

1. David Carhart praised Public Works on snow removal.

ACTION ITEMS:

1. A **MOTION** to approve the minutes dated January 5, 2026 and January 26, 2026 was made by Donnelly, seconded by Capone. All were in favor. **MOTION** carried.
2. Manager Reider stated the borough applied for multiple grants through CDBG and received funding to fund a portion of the North Main Street Storm Sewer Project. Reider stated that there is no stormwater infrastructure along North Main Street which has led to runoff concerns during wet weather. A **MOTION** was made by Capone, seconded by Sperling to approve advertisement of the North Main Street Storm Sewer Project. All were in favor. **MOTION** carried.
3. Manager Reider and Council discussed updating/amending the Zoning, Snow Removal, and the Vehicles, Traffic and Parking Ordinances.

COUNCIL COMMENTS:

1. Chief Jones stated that the call volume has increased by approximately 100 calls when compared to January of last year.
2. Mayor McCloughan updated Council on his recent activities as Mayor.
3. Council Member Sperling stated that the call volume for the Fire Department has increased. Sperling asked for prayers for a 20-year member of the Bangor Fire Department.
4. Council Member Maslany had questions on sidewalk snow removal. Manager Reider addressed his questions. Maslany stated that he will have a Slate Belt Rising update at the next Council meeting
5. Council Member Donnelly commented about the snow-covered vehicles in South Bangor.
6. Solicitor Ceraul complimented Public Works on snow removal.
7. Manager Reider gave Council a Public Works and grant update.
8. Council President Kresge would like to issue a proclamation recognizing Public Works and Al Bilsky for the recent snow event.
