

LIFEGUARD

GENERAL DESCRIPTION: A Lifeguard employed with Bangor Borough is responsible for the health, safety and welfare of the guests using Borough swimming pool. A Lifeguard's major responsibility is to observe swimmers and enforce regulations in the guarding of life and the prevention of accidents at the pool. Lifeguards perform other duties such as cleaning the pool and the pool area. They remove objects from the water, pick up lost articles, dispose of trash from the pool area, and are responsible for putting chlorine and other chemicals into the water. The pool will be open from approximately May 30th until August 23rd. Individuals 16 years or older may apply. Pay range is \$11.00-\$14.00/hour, 20-30 hours per week. Bangor Borough will reimburse applicants for their lifeguard certification upon successful completion.

TICKET TAKER

GENERAL DESCRIPTION: Ticket takers are responsible for checking pool passes and taking payment for admission into the Bangor Memorial Park Pool. The pool will be open from approximately May 30th until August 23rd. Individuals 14 years or older may apply. Applicants under the age of 16 will be required to have working papers and parent/guardian consent. Pay range is \$7.50-\$10.00/hour, 20-30 hours per week.
