PUBLIC COMMENT:

1. David Carhart commented that construction is moving along at 207 Market Street.

ACTION ITEMS:

1. A **MOTION** to approve the minutes dated February 9, 2026 and February 23, 2026 was made by Donnelly, seconded by Capone. All were in favor. **MOTION** carried.
2. Council President Kresge read a proclamation honoring the Bangor Borough Public Works Department and Al Bilsky for their snow removal activities during winter storm Fern. A **MOTION** was made by Donnelly, seconded by Capone to approve the amended proclamation for the Bangor Public Works Department and Al Bilsky. All were in favor. **MOTION** carried.
3. Manager Reider stated that the signalized intersection at Routes 191 and Market Street needs updating. Manager Reider reported that he received a cost estimate of approximately \$450,000.00 and he intends to apply for the Green Light Go Grant. A Resolution is needed as part of the grant application due to the borough needing to enter into a Traffic Signal Maintenance Agreement with PennDOT. A **MOTION** was made by Capone, seconded by Sperling to adopt the Resolution. All were in favor. **MOTION** carried.
4. A **MOTION** was made by Donnelly, seconded by Capone to approve the PennDOT TSMA (Traffic Signal Maintenance Agreement). All were in favor. **MOTION** carried.
5. Manager Reider, Council, Teddy Reed and Chief Jones discussed the draft Vehicles, Traffic and Parking Ordinance and the Street Excavation Ordinance.

COUNCIL COMMENTS:

1. Chief Jones stated that call volume has increased and he congratulated Public Works on their well-deserved proclamation. Chief Jones asked for thoughts and prayers for the family of Pennsylvania State Police Corporal Timothy O'Connor who was shot and killed during a traffic stop in West Caln Township.
2. Mayor McCloughan congratulated Public Works and Al Bilsky on their proclamation. The Mayor stated that the Park Board will have a 250th Anniversary of America Celebration on July 5th at the Bangor Memorial Park.
3. Council Member Sperling stated that Bangor's 150th Time Capsule Burial Event will be held at Bethel Park on April 25th at 10:00 A.M. with a rain date of April 26th at 1:00 P.M. The Heritage Center asked that members of Council be present.
4. Council Member Donnelly thanked Chief Jones, Sergeant Sabatine and Officer Lillis for their assistance during a recent incident at her residence.

5. Manager Reider stated that the Borough's first electronics recycling event will be held on March 21st from 9am to 11am.
Reider gave Council a Public Works update.
Reider is interviewing for the Parking Enforcement Position and the full-time Police Officer position was posted.
6. Council President Kresge advised Council that due to family obligations he will be absent from some Council Meetings in the future.

A **MOTION** to adjourn was made by Donnelly, seconded by Capone. All were in favor. **MOTION** carried.
